We will perform the following work and provide the materials indicated:

- 1. The court will be high pressure washed as needed.
- 2. The entire court area will be blown clean using 8 H.P. blowers.
- 3. The structural and random cracks will be cleaned and filled with a combination of Deco Binder, Portland cement and 50 grit silica sand. Following this process these areas will be mechanically sanded.
- 4. The structural cracks will then be covered with either the Armor or Rite Way membrane crack system. These membranes will be covered with 2 coats of acrylic resurfacer.
- 5. The court will be covered with a three coat system of Deco 100% acrylic tennis court surfacing.
- 6. The lines will be painted white.
